

UKCC LEVEL 2 – PREREQUISITS AND FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

The Level 2 Certificate in Coaching Badminton enables you to coach independently and enables you to plan linked coaching sessions.

COURSE PREREQUISITS

Candidates are required to:

- be at least 18 years of age on the first day of the course
- hold a Level 1 Certificate in Coaching Badminton (UKCC) or equivalent (BADMINTON England Level 1, BADMINTON Scotland Instructors award or the Welsh Badminton Union Leaders Award) and be able to demonstrate the competences required to achieve the UKCC Level 1 qualification.

Before progressing to the level 2 Certificate in Coaching Badminton, it is also advised that coaches have gained some coaching experience, working with a more qualified coach.

Those candidates who do not have a UKCC level 1 Certificate in Coaching Badminton will have the opportunity to update their knowledge via a 'Home Study Pack' which includes a series of short questions and tasks prior to the course. If you are unsure about any of the information above please do not hesitate to contact either your Badminton Regional Officer or County Coaching Secretary for guidance.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

I can't attend all the days of the course. Can I still attend?

No, you must be able to attend all three days when booking onto the course. You are unable to mix days on different courses.

What happens if I miss any of the days of the course?

If you miss any day of the course, unless there are extenuating circumstances (such as illness), you will be charged a fee of £45.00 to attend a different course. If you are unable to attend due to illness then you must provide BADMINTON England with a doctor's note within five working days of the day that you missed.

Can I still attend the course if I haven't got a level 1 qualification?

If you haven't got a level 1 qualification you have the option of going through a process called 'Accreditation of Prior Learning'. APL takes into account other coaching qualifications that you may hold in different sports and any previous experience and knowledge you have. You must be 18 years of age on the first day of the course. There are no extenuating circumstances.
